
Venues

Practical information


Climate

Berlin's climate is oceanic. Average temperature: max.: $7-19^{\circ}$ C (45 - 66°F); min: 2 - 11°C (36 - 51°F). Aside from scattered showers, weather in Berlin is relatively predictable.

Electricity

Voltage: 220-240 Volts

Electrical sockets (outlets) in Germany (Deutschland) are one of the two European standard electrical socket types: The "Type C" Europlug and the "Type E" and "Type F" Schuko. If your appliance's plug doesn't match the shape of these sockets, you will need a travel plug adapter in order to plug in.



VAT

The normal VAT rate is 19 percent, a reduced rate of 7 percent applies to certain consumer goods and everyday services (such as food, newspapers, local public transport, hotel stays).
