Legislative state of play

Final adoption of InvestEU Regulation subject to agreement on overall MFF, but still expected for end 2019

Remaining pending items: budgetary envelope, overall climate target and third countries

Two delegated acts foreseen by Regulation (Investment Guidelines and Scoreboard) to be adopted once legal base in place



Involvement of potential implementing partners 1/3

Consultation on Investment Guidelines

Presentation of new version during next session

Deadline for comments: 31 August

Consultation of co-legislators: September

Adoption by Commission, subject to overall MFF agreement and final adoption of InvestEU Regulation: end 2019

In the absence of an objection by co-legislators within 2 months, the Delegated Act on the Investment Guidelines will be adopted
